Since January our volunteers have been working hard in covering all different types of events across Gibraltar. We have attended the Three Kings Cavalcade, the Gibsams Fun Run, the latest RGP Community day and a recent Rugby event to name a few!



Within February we were given the opportunity to assist the GHA with a cross border transfer of a new born up to the San Antonio hospital in Malaga. We were very happy to report all went well, and we proudly brought mother and baby back to Gibraltar.

In addition to our successful events and transfers, we also completed the First Response Emergency Care

Level 3 course (FREC3) via Quallsafe. This is a huge achievement within our training programme as it enables members of the public and our volunteers to expand their First Aid knowledge and assist where they can within the field of their employment or volunteering role all as First Responders!

Ongoing Training

Our volunteers are currently re-qualifying in their Medical Gases course, this enables our volunteers to administer oxygen and Entonox when a patient requires it.
